

How to Download Sermons on iTunes

A Step-by-Step Guide

1. If you do not have iTunes installed, go to <http://www.apple.com/itunes>. Locate the “Download iTunes” button at the right and click on it. Otherwise, you may skip to step

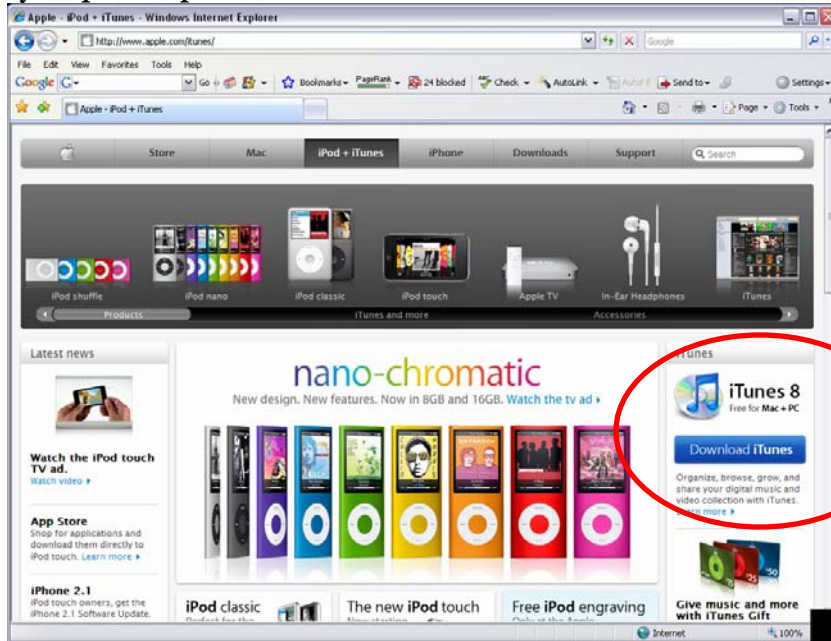


Figure 1.1 – The Apple iTunes website.

2. On the page that follows, uncheck the checkboxes on the left, and then click the “Download Now” button.

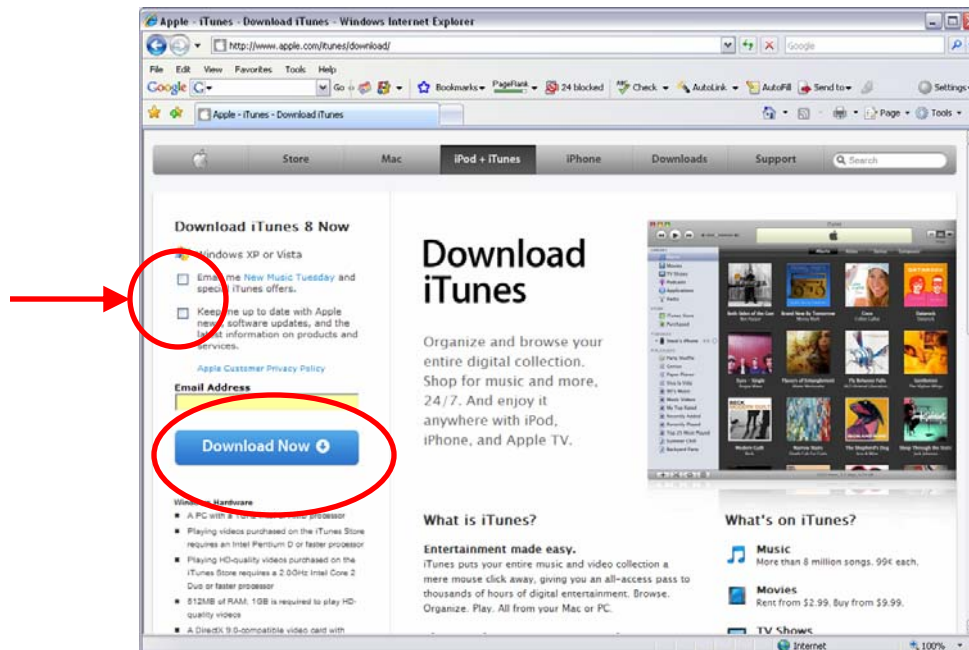


Figure 2.1 – The Download iTunes web page.

3. If asked whether you wish to save or run the file, choose “Run.” You may also choose “Save” if you wish to only download the file and run it later.

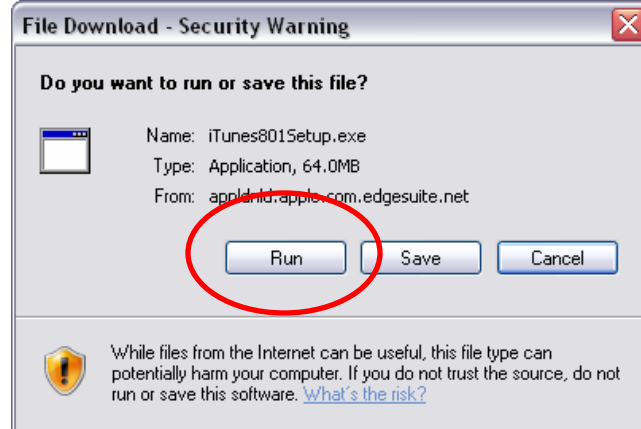


Figure 3.1 – The File Download prompt.

4. Wait for iTunes to download. This may take a while depending on your connection speed.

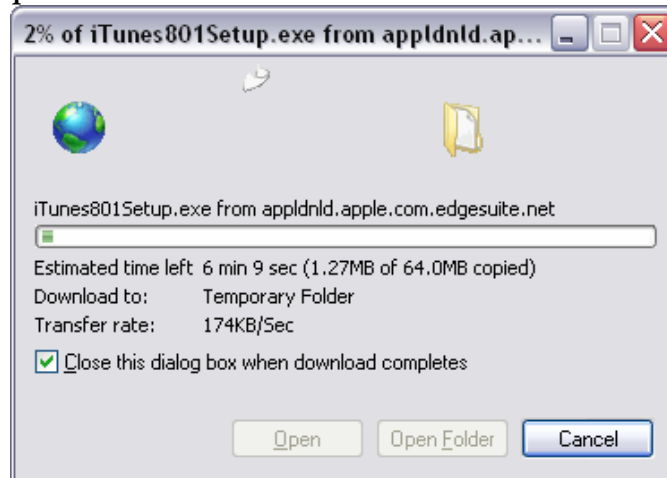


Figure 4.1 – The Download window.

5. Once the download completes, you may be prompted whether you wish to run the file. Choose to “Run.”

6. The iTunes Installer will appear. Click “Next” to continue the installation.

7. Make sure the “I accept...” option is selected and click the “Next” button. Feel free to read the License Agreement, but there shouldn’t be anything in there which should concern you.

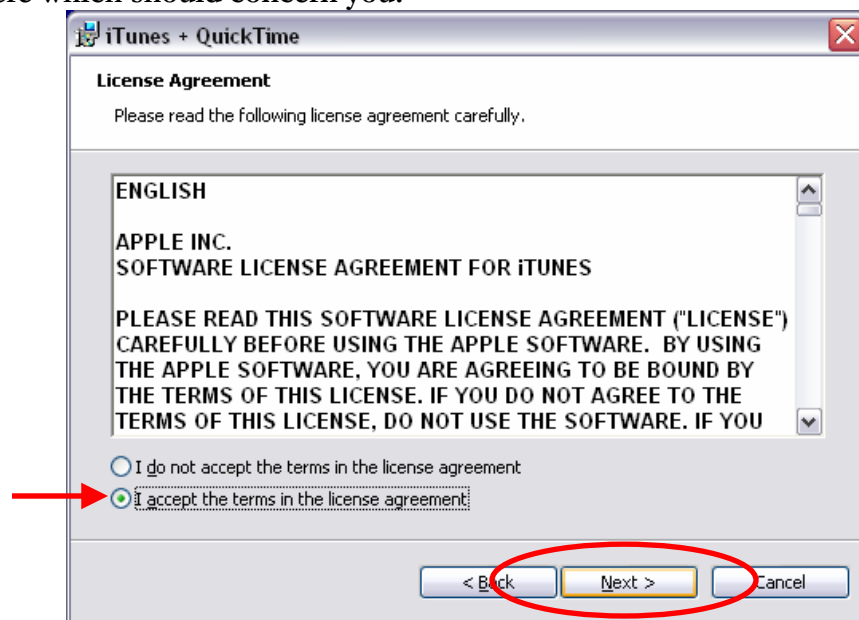


Figure 7.1 – The End User License Agreement. You can accept this without worrying.

8. It is advisable that you add an icon for iTunes to your desktop so you can find it easily later, but ultimately that is up to you. Check the box if you wish to have an icon on your desktop. Likewise, if you already have a program for playing music files, you do not want to make iTunes the default program for playing such files. If, on the other hand, you don't have any other programs for playing music files, iTunes is a good program for doing so. Check the box if you wish to have all your audio files open in iTunes when you double-click them. Once you've decided on these two options, click the "Install" button to begin the actual installation. Then, sit back and wait while iTunes installs to your computer.

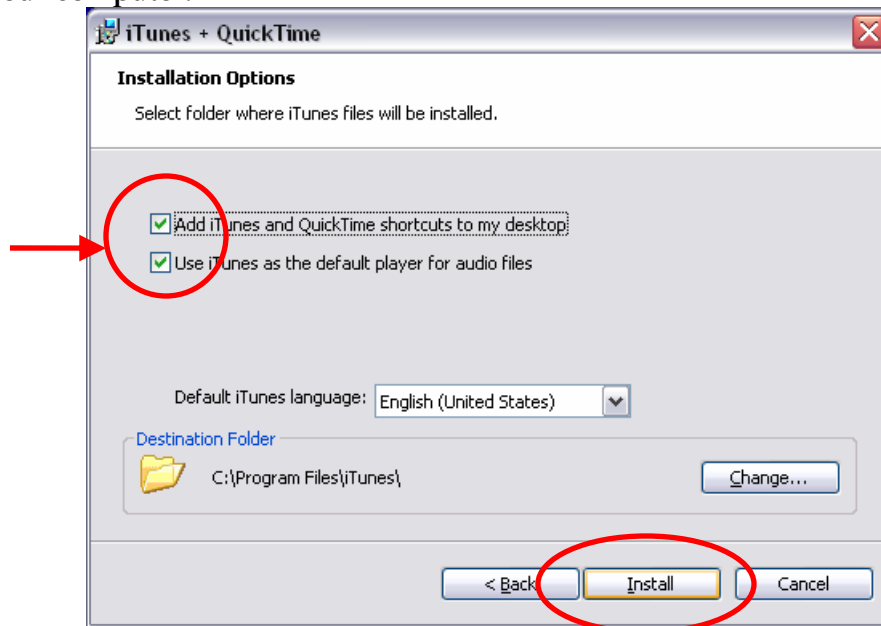


Figure 8.1 – Select your options and then click "Install."

9. Once the installation is done, leave the “Open iTunes” option checked and click “Finish.”

10. The first time you open iTunes, you may be presented with another License Agreement screen. Again, there shouldn't be anything in the license agreement that should concern you, but feel free to read it anyhow. When you are ready to proceed, click the “Agree” button.
11. To subscribe to the Holy Cross Sermons podcast, open a web browser and navigate to the church's webpage: <http://holycrosslcms.org>. Click on the podcast icon under the “Sermons Podcast” heading at the left.

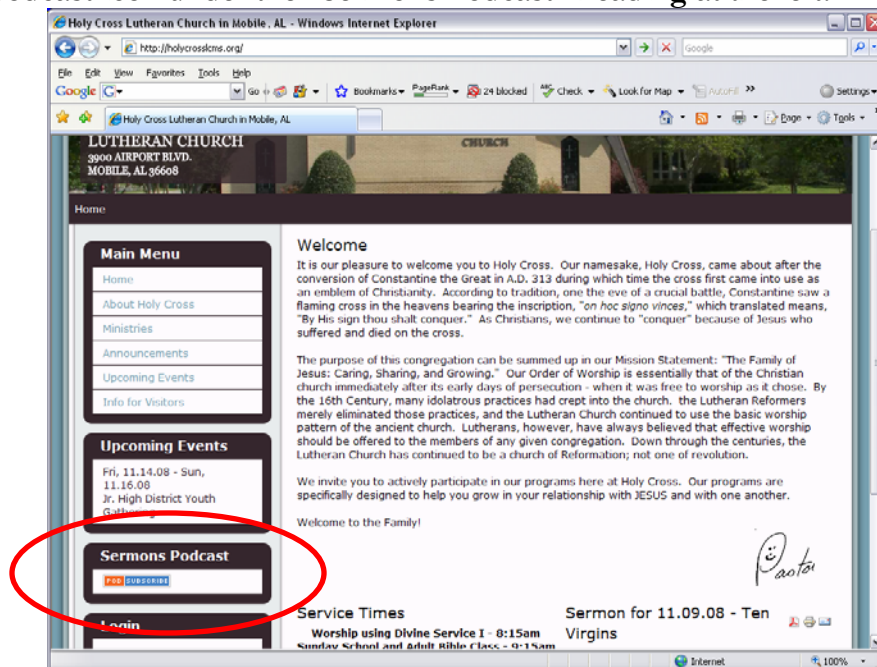


Figure 11.1 – Click on the podcast icon to subscribe to the podcast in iTunes.

12. A window may appear asking if you wish to launch the URL in iTunes. Click on the appropriate button to do so. iTunes should then open (if it is not already) and go to the “Podcasts” section. There, you will find the latest sermon is already downloading. If you wish to download and listen to previous sermons, click the triangle next to “Holy Cross Sermons” to see the list of available sermons. Click “Get” to get a single sermon or click “Get All” to download all available sermons. Double-click to listen to a sermon. Enjoy!

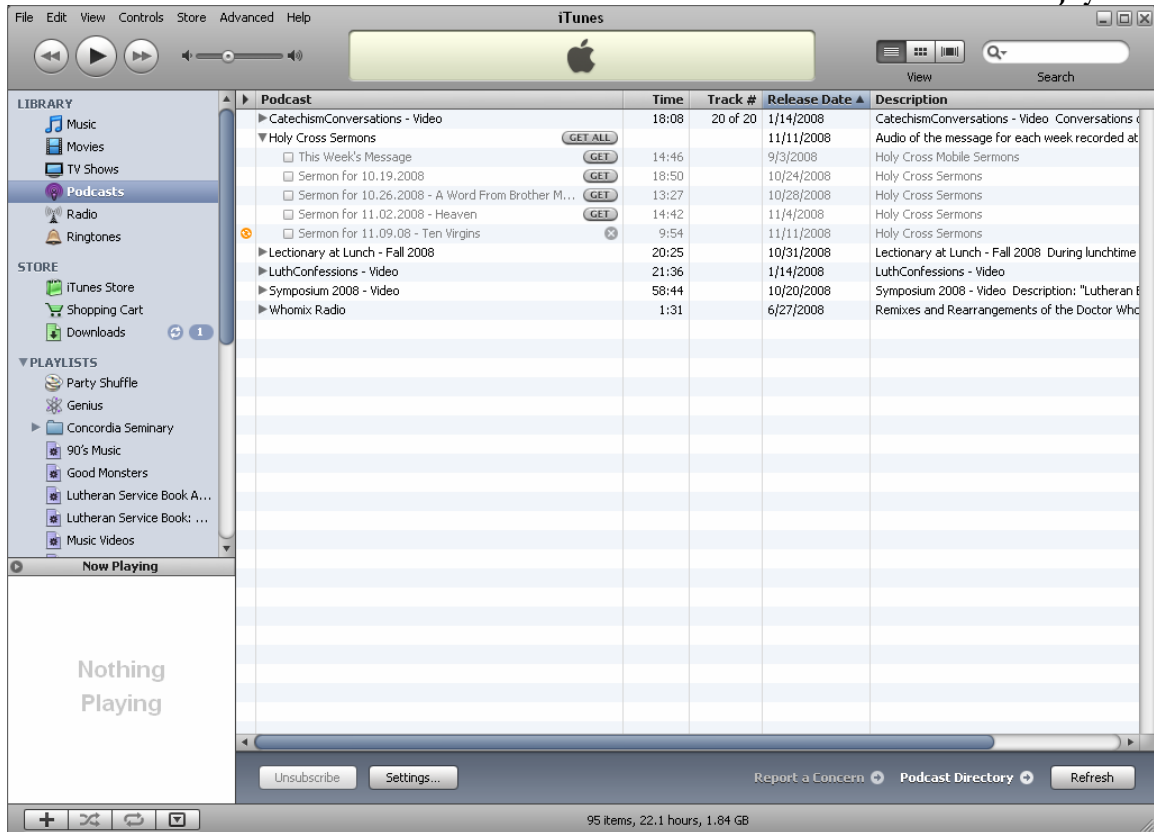


Figure 12.1 – iTunes subscribed to Holy Cross Sermons podcast. Click “Get” to get one sermon or “Get All” to download all available sermons. Whenever you open iTunes, the latest sermon will be downloaded if you do not already have it on your computer.
